## Wacky Cake

3 cups flour  
2 cups sugar  
½ cup cocoa  
2 t baking soda  
½ t salt  
2 cups cold water  
¾ cup oil or applesauce  
2 t vinegar  
2 t vanilla  
½ cup chocolate chips  
½ cup peanut butter chips

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix together flour, sugar, cocoa, baking soda, and salt. Add water, oil, vinegar, vanilla and chips. Wisk till blended. Pour into 13 x 9 pan. Bake 35 – 40 minutes.

Note: There are no eggs in this cake.
